### The Big Scream on the Big Screen: Psycho

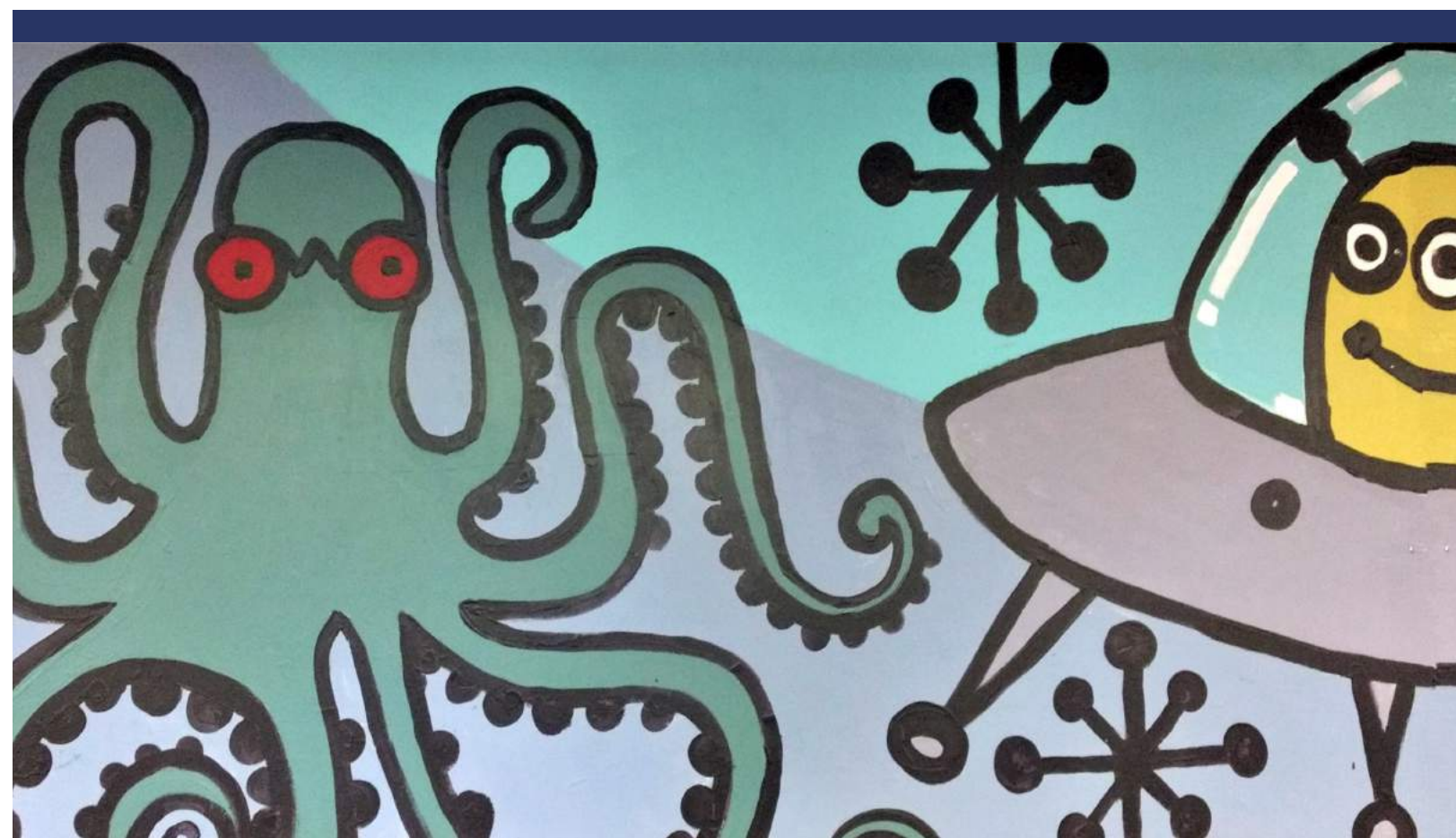

**It's no mystery that fantastic partnerships, services, and materials can be found at GPL!** Take a walk around the building on your next visit and we promise you'll discover something unknown to you—like the new mural in the Children's Department! Thanks to the creative talents of Bryn Du Art Center's Paul Hamilton, Jenn Pentecost, and the young artists of BDAC, our former blank display space is now home to a whimsical piece of art featuring Bigfoot, the Loch Ness Monster, and a host of other cryptids. Its style is consistent with the 2013 GSVA-sponsored mural and has a muted color palette to appeal to the older youth whose books are shelved in that area. Cryptids were selected due to their wide-ranging, enduring appeal as well as the spirit of curiosity they invoke.

Also spotted around the building are two new 3-D printers for public use, a Keurig machine to help you shake the autumn chill (\$1 per cup of hot chocolate, tea, or coffee), a new Community Engagement office and workspace, and an ever-changing art display hosted by local artists.


